SOCIAL SECURITY FACTS

The Social Security Administration turned 67 last month. There are more than 45 million people currently receiving Social Security benefits (and more than 175 million who have benefited from the income it provides.) The first card issued was 055-09-0001, belonging to shipping clerk John D Sweeney, Jr, age 23 of New Rochelle, NY. Sweeney died of a heart attack in 1974 at the age of 61 without ever receiving Social Security Benefits. His widow, however, received benefits based on his work until her death in 1982.

The lowest possible SSN (001-01-00010) was actually issued to Grace D. Owen of Concord, NH. She was the first applicant from New Hampshire, the state where then-Social Security Board Chairman John G Winant resided. (He declined to have a SSN registered to him.)
